Wednesday, November 4th, 8:00 AM –1:30 PM

- Children ages 6 months to 24 months (healthy and high risk)
This vaccine contains preservative that has been approved by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. Parents are encouraged to call 660-665-8491 for more information.
- Children ages 24 months to 59 months
- Caregivers of children age birth thru 36 months (healthy and high risk, caregivers are defined as anyone caring for this age child including daycare, parents, babysitters, etc.)
- Pregnant women

Wednesday, November 4th, 1:30 PM – 6:00 PM

- Children ages 24 months to 18 years (healthy and high risk)
- Pregnant women

Friday November, 6th, 8:00 AM – 12 Noon and 12:30 PM to 4:00 PM

- Persons ages 18 years thru 24 years (healthy and high risk)
- Pregnant women

The public is advised to receive further updates from television, radio, and newspaper on vaccination target groups, as well as clinic dates and times. Please remember that quantities of vaccine are limited. Clinics will be held at the Adair County Health Department, 1001 S. Jamison Street, Kirksville MO 63501.
